Step 4: Bacterial Meningitis Shot

Wrangler Express Center, Saulsbury Campus Center The shot is required for all students under the age of 22 prior to registration. *NOTE: SHOT EXPIRES AFTER 5 YEARS, ENSURE THAT YOUR VACCINATION OR BOOSTER IS CURRENT.

Step 5: Official Transcripts
