

## **Odessa College ADN Program Application Checklist**

Incomplete applications will <u>not</u> be accepted. Applications must be submitted with <u>all</u> required components upon submission to the nursing program.

- ☐ Meet with School of Health & Sciences Academic Success Coach to complete the Transcript Checklist PRIOR to application submission. The checklist is located with the program application. Required prerequisites must be taken <u>prior</u> to application to the program.
  - o BIOL 2401- must be a "C" or better and taken within 5 years of application
  - o BIOL 2402- must be a "C" or better and taken within 5 years of application
  - PSYC 1300 (If wanting to substitute ENGL 1301, please speak with your Success Coach)
  - HUMA (1305, 2319 or 2323 choice of one) Please speak with your Success Coach about approved substitutions
  - PSYC 2314 (PSYC 2301 can be substituted)
- ☐ ADN application and Transcript Checklist
- TEAS Scores (expires after 3 years) \*IF YOU ARE APPLYING AFTER 4/1/26, SEE ADMISSION GUIDE FOR INFORMATION ON HESI EXAM REQUIREMENTS
  - Minimum Reading score 69.9
  - Minimum Math score 63.3
- ☐ Enrolled as a current Odessa College student and have a high school diploma or GED
  - Must submit all previous official transcripts to Odessa College Records Office
  - Copy of transcripts must be submitted to the Nursing Office with your application. Unofficial copies will be accepted by the program.
- ☐ LVN License (if applying for the Transition program)

Health record components are <u>NOT</u> required to submit for application to the program. However, applicants are strongly encouraged to submit all health record documents if they have them. Please refer to the ADN Admissions Guide for more information.

- Traditional Program (Main Campus): May 1<sup>st</sup> end of Maymester term. Check date on the OC Associate Degree Nursing website, the Nursing office, or your Success Coach

- Summer Transition Cohort (Main Campus): March 1st March 20th
